

Installation Guide for Auto-Out® Microwave with Quick-Connect Brackets

Supplies and Tools Required:

- Auto-Out Microwave (Left unit and Right unit) with Quick-Connect brackets
- Philips Screwdriver—standard size to fit the microwave screws (not included)
- Tape Measure (not included)



Measure clearance:



Measure from the cooktop surface to the bottom of the microwave to ensure required clearance of 15-27 inches.

Loosen microwave screws:



2.a Find the screws of the metal panel underneath the microwave (where the filters are located).

2.b Use a screwdriver to loosen the screws along the front of the metal panel.



Align bracket:



Open the microwave door; center the Left Auto-Out Microwave (marked L) over the middle of the front left burner and lift up.



Install bracket:



Slide Quick-Connect bracket into place between the bottom of the microwave and the metal panel (where space was just created by loosening the screws); push in until the bracket is flush with the edge of the panel. 5

Repeat steps 3 & 4 for right side of cooktop:



Repeat steps 3 & 4 to align and install the Right Auto-Out Microwave (marked R) on the right side of the microwave. Measure to ensure you have a minimum of 9.5" from center of Left unit to center of Right unit.



Tighten screws:



Using the screwdriver, tighten the loosened screws on front of metal panel of microwave. Auto-Out Microwave installation is now complete.
